Upon confirmation of eligibility, each applicant will be invited to become a member and will be introduced as a new member at our last General Membership Meeting of the 2020-2021 League Year on May 4, 2021 and our first General Membership Meeting of the 2021-2022 League year on September 7, 2021.

NEW MEMBER CLASS RESPONSIBILITIES

Members of the 2021-2022 New Member Class will be expected to:

- 1. Attend a minimum of 6 out of 9 monthly General Membership Meetings**
Meetings are held on the first Tuesday of each month, September 2021 – May 2022, at 6:30 p.m. at the Junior League Lodge.
- 2. Attend a minimum of 4 out of 6 monthly New Member Class Meetings**
Meetings will be held on the third Tuesday of each month, September 2021 – March 2022 at 6:30 p.m. at the Junior League Lodge.
- 3. Complete one “Done in a Day Project”**
These projects are designated by the Junior League for a local non-profit agency. This is usually done together as a New Member Class.
- 4. Pay dues of \$350**
Dues include a ticket for the New Member and a guest to the Junior League’s annual Charity Ball, annual dues to AJLI, aid in our Community Outreach division, and a ticket to May Dinner 2022.

If at any time a New Member finds that she is unable to complete the New Member requirements, she may resign in good standing and may be reinstated to complete the course another year.
